HOLY WEEK & EASTER SUNDAY (updated)

These services are now available to book online. **Good Friday is now fully booked at Holy Name & St Mary's. The Easter Vigil at Holy Name is also fully booked. If you cannot book online, we regret that you will not get a place.**

Maundy Thursday, The Mass of the Lord's Supper – 7.30pm at Assumption & St Mary's, 8pm at Holy Name. Due to COVID, there will be no washing of feet. The Blessed Sacrament will be reserved in the Tabernacle, so there will be no Stripping of the Altars or Watching with Our Lord.

Good Friday, The Lord's Passion & Death – 3pm all 3 churches. The congregation will Venerate the Cross by genuflecting or bowing profoundly, whilst staying in their places. We have now been told that we may have the Passion in 3 voices. However, the Narrator will read the crowd parts.

Easter Vigil – 7.30pm at St Mary's, 8pm at Holy Name. The Paschal candle will be lit at the beginning of Mass. There will be no congregational candles. Father will read the shorter form of the Exultet. There will be 3 Old Testament readings, with their psalms, instead of the usual 5. We will renew our Baptismal vows, but there will be no sprinkling of holy water.

Easter Sunday – all Masses as usual

ASSUMPTION PASCHAL CANDLE

Since there will be no 'new fire' at the Easter Vigil this year, Father will bless your paschal candle at the 9.45am Mass on Easter Sunday.

GOOD FRIDAY STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Those who are unable to get a place at the Good Friday 3pm services may find comfort in attending the Stations of the Cross, which will take place at both **Holy Name & St Mary's at 10am**. Everyone is welcome to attend - no need to book. If the churches are full, we'll hold them outside!
