END HUNGER UK

The SVP Leeds Central Council has asked conferences to promote a petition urging the government to make improvements to Universal Credit to ensure it does not leave more people at risk of debt and destitution. End Hunger UK's national petition is calling on the Prime Minister to fix Universal Credit to prevent people going hungry. Evidence from frontline food aid providers across the UK reveals that the rollout of Universal Credit is currently causing hardship for vulnerable people and putting pressure on emergency food supplies. The petition is designed to send a powerful message to the Prime Minister – it's time to fix Universal Credit. The petition will be delivered to 10 Downing Street in the lead-up to the Autumn Budget in mid-November. The petition and accompanying information is at the back of St Mary's Church for those who wish to sign.
